**Class Fees:** Intro: \$23.00; Training: \$28.00; First/Second: \$33.00  
Third/Fourth/Freestyles: \$38.00, FEI: \$45.00

**Qualifying Classes:** Must be entered in the appropriate Jr/YR, AA, or Open class. Add \$10.00 for each qualifying test.

**Camper or RV:** \$25 per night for camper hook-ups. \$15 per night for tent camping.

**Office Charge:** \$25 per horse/rider combination.

**Payment:** Entries accepted by mail; check must accompany entry. No credit cards accepted; no entries accepted by fax or email.

**Late Entries:** \$20 flat fee on all late entries (received after closing date) plus an additional \$5 per class; post entries, changes in the rider or horse also subject to \$5 per class fee.

**Concessions:** Concession stand on grounds during show hours.

**Stabling/Tack Fees:** \$80 for stall from Thur-Sun or \$70 for stall from Fri - Sun for a horse. All horses must be stabled. \$40 for weekend for tack stall. \$40 per "day" for either a horse or tack stall. Stall "days" are 24 hour periods defined as: 3 PM Friday – 3 PM Saturday and 3 PM Saturday – 3 PM Sunday

**Bedding:** One bag provided. Extra bedding at \$7 per bag may be ordered on the entry form or from show office while supplies last.

**Non-competing horse:** \$50 for horses not competing; Must fill out entry form for number and pay office and stabling fees.

**Refunds:** Entries canceled on or before closing date will receive a 100% refund of all fees. No refund of entries if canceled after the closing date.

**Times:** Unofficial times will be mailed to all riders one week before the show. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule.

**Awards:** Ribbons to sixth place in all classes except qualifying classes. Champion high point will also be awarded at each division and level. Divisions (Jr/YR, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately; riders may only enter one division per class. Champions and Reserve awarded for highest average percentage (must enter at least 2 classes per level to qualify.)

**Stabling and tack:** Permanent stalls with doors available on the fairgrounds. Some stalls may be 8' x 8'. Please contact secretary if a larger stall is necessary.

**Arenas:** All classes in large sand arenas. Warm-up areas are on sand or sand and grass footing.

**Other:** All dogs must be leashed. All horses must have a current (within current calendar year) Coggins test. Submit copy with entry. Horses not entered in the show may not be brought onto the show grounds without prior consent from the management. No smoking in stall areas or show office.

Office fee: \$15 per combination; Horses will be given a different number for the schooling and the recognized shows. Horses that enter only the schooling show may school on grounds during the recognized show for no additional fees but must follow USEF Rules

Dress code for schooling show is casual but neat and safe! All classes in a standard size dressage arena. **Late Entries:** \$25 per show if postmarked and received after the closing/received by date.

Will be taken as scheduling permits - Class fee plus \$10.00.

**Rider/Handler/Horse Change:** \$25 for either rider/handler or horse change after entries submitted.

**Stabling/Tack Stall Fees:** Both shows: \$125 for entire show weekend stall (Barns C/D/E), initial bedding not included.

\$150 for entire show weekend stall (Barns A/B), initial bedding not included.

Show weekend is 12pm Thursday - 6pm Sunday.

Show I (Friday - Saturday): \$100 for stall (Barns C/D/E), initial bedding not included (12 pm Thursday - 6 pm Saturday) \$125 for stall (Barns A/B), initial bedding not included.

Sport horse entries - for Friday classes only \$50.00 (Barns C/D/E only - 12 pm Thursday to 6 pm Friday)

**Arenas:** Outdoor arenas have all-weather sand footing. Warmup rings are same footing. All tests in standard arena - in case of overflow, show may elect to run some classes in a short arena. Posted schooling schedule.

**Awards for USEF Classes:** Divisions (Jr/Yg, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately. Riders must clearly specify division choice. When no designation is made, riders will automatically be entered as open. Riders may enter only one division per class. Trophy (in classes of 3 or more) and ribbons to sixth for each class. No awards for Qualifying classes. Championships and reserves awarded for the highest percentage at each USEF/FEI level in each division.

**Stabling and tack:** Permanent 10 x 10 stalls with gates on the showgrounds. All horses must have a stall. Feed, hay and bedding will be sold at the show. Competitors are responsible for stall damage. **SMOKING IS PROHIBITED IN STALL AREAS.** Stabling requests honored when possible - preference given to those requesting stabling for entire show weekend. **Divisions:** (Jr/YR, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately. No awards for Qualifying class. Special breed awards and IaDCTA member awards will be given. Breed awards require proof of registration. All awards are given at the show.

**Championships:** Iowa Dressage Classic I & II combined championships will be awarded in the Jr/YR, AA, and Open divisions for Training and First levels and in the Open division for Second, Third, Fourth, and FEI levels for the horse/rider combination with the highest average percentage. Must include scores from both Saturday and Sunday. Training through Third levels must show in at least 3 classes. Fourth and FEI must show in at least 2 classes.

**Jackpot Classes:** Jackpot classes will be offered for First level, Test 1 classes (111J, 111A and 111O) on Saturday and for Training level, Test 2 classes (202J, 202A and 202O) on Sunday.

In order to compete for the jackpot payback, the following are necessary:

- 1) Must be entered in the designated class.
- 2) Must enter and ride another test of that level either Saturday or Sunday.
- 3) Must pay the \$10 jackpot fee for the jackpot class.

The jackpot payback will be 100% of the jackpot fees collected. Jackpots will be distributed for Jr/YR/AA (combined) and Open participants. Payback will be 50% for the highest score, 30% for the next highest score and 20% for the third highest score among jackpot participants.

**Arena:** Outdoor sand/dirt ring. Sand/dirt warmup area. Training level tests 1, 2 and 3 may be in a small (20m x 40m) ring. Training level test 4 through FEI will be in a standard (20m x 60m) ring. Competition arena will be closed at approximately 9 p.m. each night.
