

**Refunds:** Before closing date, all fees minus office fee. After closing date, entry fees refunded only if original veterinary certificate is received by the secretary prior to the start of the show. No refund of stabling or office fees after closing date.

**Times:** Show management will mail or email ride times to all riders approximately 1 week prior to the show. Ride times will be posted on [www.DressageShowInfo.com](http://www.DressageShowInfo.com). Adequate time intervals cannot be guaranteed when riders enter more than two horses for the show.

**Awards:** Trophy and six ribbons for each class.

**Divisions:** (Jr/YR, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately. No awards for Qualifying class. Special breed awards and IaDCTA member awards will be given. Breed awards require proof of registration. All awards are given at the show.

**Championships:** Iowa Dressage Classic I & II combined championships will be awarded in the Jr/YR, AA, and Open divisions for Training and First levels and in the Open division for Second, Third, Fourth, and FEI levels for the horse/rider combination with the highest average percentage. Must include scores from both Saturday and Sunday. Training through Third levels must show in at least 3 classes. Fourth and FEI must show in at least 2 classes.

**Jackpot Classes:** Jackpot classes will be offered for First level, Test 1 classes (111J, 111A and 111O) on Saturday and for Training level, Test 2 classes (202J, 202A and 202O) on Sunday.

In order to compete for the jackpot payback, the following are necessary:

- 1) Must be entered in the designated class.
- 2) Must enter and ride another test of that level either Saturday or Sunday.
- 3) Must pay the \$10 jackpot fee for the jackpot class.

The jackpot payback will be 100% of the jackpot fees collected. Jackpots will be distributed for Jr/YR/AA (combined) and Open participants. Payback will be 50% for the highest score, 30% for the next highest score and 20% for the third highest score among jackpot participants.

**Arena:** Outdoor sand/dirt ring. Sand/dirt warmup area. Training level tests 1, 2 and 3 may be in a small (20m x 40m) ring. Training level test 4 through FEI will be in a standard (20m x 60m) ring. Competition arena will be closed at approximately 9 p.m. each night.

**Directions:** Adel is 15 minutes west of Des Moines on I-80. Take I-80 to Exit 110 (US 169). Proceed north on 169 through Adel. Continue around curve to Dallas County Fairgrounds on the left (west) side of US 169.

**Accommodations:** Camping on Grounds: RV-\$10.50/night, Tent-\$7.50/night. Hotels in Des Moines/Urbandale/Clive area: Baymont Inn (515) 221-9200, Comfort Suites (515) 276-1126.

**Management and State of Iowa Policies:** A negative EIA (Coggins) report within last 12 months is required for all horses on grounds. Horses transported into Iowa from another state are required to have a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

### *About the USDF Region 4 Adult Team Championship:*

The USDF Region Four Adult Team Championship is a unique show for Adult Riders, featuring team competition in dressage, educational programs, team medals and a mounted awards ceremony. The purpose of the USDF Team Championship is to provide an opportunity for adults to compete in a team-like atmosphere. This competition is to encourage camaraderie and support for all adults competing in any level. The United States Dressage Federation (USDF) is sponsoring a Championship in each region so adult riders everywhere can join the fun! There are **no prerequisites or qualifying scores required** to enter the championships. A competitor is an adult from the beginning of the calendar year in which he/she reaches the age of 22.

**Team formation:** Teams will be organized as scramble teams. Team members can be riding at different levels. Only one professional per team allowed. Team trees may be organized according to dressage organizations, farms, barns, instructors, riding clubs, or just groups of individuals. Any individual rider needing team members is encouraged to send in his or her entry and a mixed team will be formed. See, every one can attend!!

**Team names:** Have fun with this! Here are some examples: The Grand Prix Wanabees, The Mountsters, Old in Age/Wild in Heart, The Temple Terrors, etc. *Entry form must include team name.*

**Awards:** USDF Team medallions on neck ribbons will be awarded to each team member for first through sixth places in each division. Divisions with more than six teams will be split or at the managements choice. Individual High Score Champion and Reserve in each division will be awarded rosettes - this will be determined from the highest test of the level. In addition, special awards will be awarded by individual sponsors for performance in the show.

**Team Spirit Award:** All riders are encouraged to support their fellow teammates by helping each other braid, tack up, get dusted off, watch each other's rides, and applaud each other's efforts! In addition, keeping tack rooms in order and horses well cared for are all part of the team player's duty. A special award will be awarded to the team who best displays team spirit.

**Award ceremony:** Riders are expected to be dressed in riding clothes and mounted for the awards ceremony held Friday after the final class. Procedures will be reviewed on Thursday evening.

**Competitor's picnic:** All competitors are required to be present at the picnic and pre-competition meeting on Thursday at 6pm on the show grounds. Picnic is free to all riders. Others may purchase a ticket for \$10 on entry form. The competition procedures will be reviewed.



## Rules for the USDF Region 4 Adult Championships:

All classes are open to riders who as competitors are an adult from the beginning of the calendar year in which he/she reaches the age of 22 and is competing on either horses or ponies.

Current USEF, FEI, and USDF Introductory Level tests will be used.

On the day of the competition, while on the grounds, including the stabling area, the horse or pony may only be ridden by the adult rider that will be competing it.

Tests may be called. Whips are not allowed.

**Training - Fourth Level dress:** Short or cutaway riding coat with tie, choker or stock tie, breeches or jodhpurs, boots or jodhpur boots, a hunt cap or riding hat with a hard shell, derby or top hat. **FEI:** Top hat, tails, and spurs required.

Horses and ponies manes should be braided - this is optional.

**How to Enter:** Each competitor will ride two tests of their choice from the available class list, which must be at the same or adjoining levels, except for those in the FEI divisions who will ride only one test.

**Scoring and Team Formation - please refer to the guideline published in the *Dressage Lite* prize list. Each team may include up to one professional.**

### Fees for the USDF Region Four Adult Championships:

Intro - Fourth: \$50 (total)

Prix St. Georges and up: \$45 (total)

These total fees include classes, stabling for Thursday evening and Friday day, and the competitors picnic on Thursday evening.

**Other Fees:**

- USEF Sr (18 years and older) non-member fee: \$25.00
- USEF fee: \$12 per horse
- Tack stall available at \$20.00 for the duration of championship only.
- No bedding. Bedding can be preordered at \$7.00 per bag or \$7.50 on grounds.
- Any necessary USDF registrations or fees

**Qualifying Classes:** Must be entered in appropriate class *and* qualifying class plus \$10.00 USDF fee.

**Stabling and tack:** Permanent and temporary stalls with doors on the showgrounds. Stabling for the horse is included in division fees. Stalls not available until 3pm of the day prior to the start of the show.

**Great American/USDF Qualifying Classes:** Qualifying classes with a **Q** in the class number will not require a separate ride. An exhibitor riding in the Open, Amateur, or Junior classes will pay an additional \$10 USDF fee to have this score entered in the Great American/USDF qualifying class at that level. Enter the class *and* the qualifying class.

**Office Charge:** \$20 per horse/rider combination -\$1 goes to admission charges

**Entry Information Requirement:** Competitors are responsible to include a copy of all memberships for horse, owner, rider, and trainer listed on entry form. A current negative coggins (within one year) must also be submitted with entry. If in freestyle class - a copy of the qualifying test must also be included in the entry.

**Late Fee:** \$25 for entries postmarked after closing date.

**Post Entries:** Will be taken as scheduling permits - Class fee plus \$10.00.

**Rider/Handler/Horse Change:** \$25 for either rider/handler or horse change after entries submitted.

**Stabling/Tack Fees:** All horses must have a stall. No initial bedding provided. \$40 for overnight stabling. (3pm day prior to 5pm the next) \$75 for weekend stall (3pm Fri - 9pm Sun) Additional nights stabling at \$40 per night. Please notify management of extra nights needed.

**Bedding:** \$7 per bag if preordered (encouraged)/ \$7.50 per bag on grounds - if ordered by 3PM. No guarantees of same day delivery if ordered after 3PM.

**Camper or RV:** \$25 per night on show grounds. Limited so reserve early.

**Faxed Entries:** Faxed entries accepted provided that a valid credit card is included to hold entry until check and original entry arrives.

**Non-competing horses:** \$50 for horses not competing - must fill out entry for number and pay office fees.

**Times:** Unofficial times will be mailed to all riders one week before the show. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. **Awards:** Divisions (Jr/Yg, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately. Riders must clearly specify division choice. When no designation is made, riders will automatically be entered as open. Riders may enter only one division per class. Trophy (in classes of 3 or more) and ribbons to sixth for each class. No awards for Qualifying classes. Championships and reserves awarded for the highest percentage at each USEF/FEI level in each division.

**Stabling and tack:** Stalls with gates on the showgrounds. Competitors are responsible for stall damage. **SMOKING IS PROHIBITED IN STALL AREAS.**

**Arenas:** Outdoor arenas have all-weather sand footing. Warmup rings are same footing. All tests in standard arena, unless entries warrant - then some tests may be held in a small arena. Competition arenas may be ridden in up to two hours before the first ride of the day and after each day's conclusion.

**Jackpot Classes:** This is a class that is open to any rider (Open, AA, Jr/YG) riding in that class, namely the highest test of that level that the Jackpot is offered. There is no additional ride or ribbons but the top three riders, based on scores, share in a jackpot of total payback of nomination fees for that level. The rider nominates for a fee of \$25 (in addition to the class fee) prior to their ride and the payback is 1st - 50%, 2nd - 30%, and 3rd - 20% of the total nomination fees for that level.

**Warning: Under the Equine Activity Liability Act, each participant who participates in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks of engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss, or damage to person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities.**

**Hazardous Weather/Acts of God/Accident and Emergency Policy:** Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents or emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any Championship or qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents or emergencies.

**Other:** All dogs must be leashed. Horses not entered in the show may not be brought onto the show grounds without prior arrangement and payment.
