Great American/USDF Qualifying Classes: Qualifying classes with a Q in the class number will not require a separate ride. An exhibitor riding in the Open, Amateur, or Junior/Young Rider classes will pay an additional \$10 USDF fee to have this score entered in the Great American/USDF qualifying class at that level. Enter the class and the qualifying class.

Office Charge: \$35 per horse/rider combination -\$1 goes to admission charges
Entry Information Requirement: Competitors are responsible to include a copy of all memberships for horse, owner, rider, and trainer listed on entry form. A current negative coggins (within one year) must also be submitted with entry. If in freestyle class or Midwest Championship class - a copy of the qualifying tests must also be included in the entry.

Entry Cancellation/Refunds: Cancellations only in writing either by mail, e-mail or fax prior to or on closing date. **No Refunds for any reason after closing date.** All fees collected on behalf of USEF to be submitted to the Federation. **Prior to or on closing date - entire entry minus office fee.**

Times: Unofficial times will be mailed to all riders one week before the show. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. Show information will be posted on show website at www.DressageShowInfo.com. Schedule posted in office by noon the day preceding the show start.

Awards for Open Show USEF Classes: Divisions (Jr/Yg, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately. Riders must clearly specify division choice. When no designation is made, riders will automatically be entered as open. Riders may enter only one division per class. Trophy (in classes of 3 or more) and ribbons to sixth for each class. No awards for Qualifying classes.

Awards for Regional Championship classes: Classes placed Champion and Reserve through eighth place for each level and listed division. Riders placing in the Great American/USDF Regional Championship classes must be present, mounted and in full riding attire for award ceremonies. Failure, without prior permission of the competition manager and/or awards coordinator, to be present and properly attired will eliminate the official placing and score and the next highest score will move up in placing. Prize money for Great American/USDF Regional Championships will be paid directly by the USDF office to the recorded horse owner within 30 days of the end of the event. Prize money will be divided equally for each class with 60% of amount per class to the Champion and 40% to the Reserve Champion. The amount of prize money to be awarded to each Champion and Reserve Champion in all levels and divisions (Open, AA, and Jr/YR) of the 2006 Championships will be announced in May of 2006.

Dressage Seat Medal Semi-Finals awards will include medals and other prizes supplied by USEF. Champion and Reserve are eligible to compete in the National Finals.

Directions: I-35 to Mason City - Clear Lake Exit. Take Hwy 122 East. Go approximately 6 miles on Hwy 122 East to second stop light. Turn left onto Eisenhower. You can see the fairgrounds from the stop light.

Workers/Volunteers: Due to the popularity of the show and the low number of volunteers usually working, we ask the each competitor take a moment and fill out the volunteer form so we can count on you to make this championship very special for everyone. You can specify working prior to the show (setting up), during the show (scribing, running, tabulation), or after the show (tear down and clean up).

Arenas: Outdoor arenas have all-weather sand footing. Warmup rings are same footing. All tests in standard arena, unless entries warrant - then some tests may be held in a small arena. Competition arenas may be ridden in up to two hours before the first ride of the day and after each day's conclusion.

Stabling and tack: Stalls with gates on the showgrounds. Competitors are responsible for stall damage. **SMOKING IS PROHIBITED IN STALL AREA.**

Awards Schedule: A tentative schedule for the Awards Ceremony will be printed in the "Show Program" and the confirmed schedule will be posted in the show secretary's office by noon the day prior to the beginning of the competition.
