**Great American/USDF Qualifying Classes for 2007 Championships:** Qualifying classes with a Q in the class number will not require a separate ride. An exhibitor riding in the Open, Adult Amateur, or Junior/Young rider classes will pay an additional \$10 USDF fee to have this score entered in the Great American/USDF qualifying class at that level. Please enter the class and the qualifying class.

**No Shows:** All "No Shows" that have not contacted the show office prior to first ride will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and time slots may be filled.

**Office Charge:** \$20 per horse/rider combination  
**Entry Information Requirement:** Competitors are responsible to include a copy of all memberships for horse, owner, rider, and trainer listed on entry form. A current negative coggins must also be submitted with entry. If in freestyle class - a copy of the qualifying test must also be included in the entry.  
**Late Entries:** \$25 per show if postmarked and received after the closing/received by date. Late fee will be waived for Sport Horses that qualify after the closing date provided that entry is made within three business days after their qualification.

**Post Entries:** Will be taken as scheduling permits - Class fee plus \$10.00.  
**Rider/Horse Change:** \$25 for either rider or horse change after entries submitted.  
**Stabling/Tack Stall Fees:** \$75 for weekend stall (Barns C/D/E), initial bedding not included \$100 for weekend stall (Barns A/B), initial bedding not included. Weekend is 12pm Friday - 6pm Sunday. Additional nights stabling (other than show dates) \$35 per night.

**Stabling and tack:** Permanent 10 x 10 stalls with gates on the showgrounds. All horses must have a stall. Competitors are responsible for stall damage. SMOKING IS PROHIBITED IN STALL AREAS. Stabling requests honored when possible.

**Bedding:** \$7 per bag. May be ordered on the entry form or from show office **by 3PM each day** - no guarantees of same day delivery if ordered after 3PM.

**Times:** Unofficial times will be mailed to all riders one week before the show. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. **Arenas:** Outdoor arenas have all-weather sand footing. Warmup rings are same footing. All tests in standard arena - in case of overflow, show may elect to run some classes in a short arena. Posted schooling schedule.

**Awards for USEF Classes:** Divisions (Jr/Yg, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately. Riders must clearly specify division choice. When no designation is made, riders will automatically be entered as open. Riders may enter only one division per class. Trophy (in classes of 3 or more) and ribbons to sixth for each class. No awards for Qualifying classes. Championships and reserves awarded for the highest percentage at each USEF/FEI level in each division.

The rider nominates for a fee of \$25 (in addition to the class fee) prior to their ride and the payback is 1st - 50%, 2nd - 30%, and 3rd - 20% of the total nomination fees for that level.

In order to compete in Classes 125-128, horses must be life-time registered with the USDF and the owner must be a USDF Participating or Business member. Verification of membership and horse registration must be provided to show management prior to competing in a Series Final Class. Two judges will evaluate each entry independently. Winners will be determined by the average score. Horses will be shown individually on the triangle at the walk and trot and standing for conformation. Late entries are permitted for the qualifiers from Friday and provided that it is done **prior** to start of the class.

**SATURDAY: SINGLE ENTRIES WELCOME, OR** you may be part of the TEAM CHALLENGE. Teams must consist of three horse/rider combinations. No horse or rider can ride twice for the same team; no combination can compete on two teams. No more than two FEI combinations per team. Each horse/rider combination must ride Test 2 and the highest test at their respective level (FEI combination rides one test). The highest score for each pair will be used; scores will be handicapped using system on opposite page. Tests may be read. Whips allowed. The number of teams may be limited. Designate a Team name and its other members on your entry form.

**SUNDAY CHAMPIONSHIPS:** You and your horse must qualify to compete in Sunday's classes by competing in a USEF recognized show in the current show season and finishing with ONE score as follows: Youth training\* -58% or higher; Training & First Level-60% or higher; Second thru Fourth Level-58% or higher; FEI-56% or higher. Copy of qualifying test must be submitted with entry. The highest test at each level will be your "Championship" test. As many classes as possible will be co-judged (two judges). Classes may be combined if entry is low. Tests must be ridden from memory and whips are allowed. The Championship classes are to test the rider's skill and the horse's training; therefore **ONLY THE QUALIFIED RIDER MAY RIDE THE QUALIFIED HORSE ON CHAMPIONSHIP DAY** (except for groom on a long rein). NOTE: Current show season is 10/01/05 - 09/30/06.

\*Youth Training Championship: A new Class for our younger competitors. Riders under 13 years of age at show date may compete in their own Youth Training Championship.

**MUSICAL FREESTYLE:** First Level and above: designate level on entry - submit a copy of qualifying test with entry.

**ENTRIES:** Saturday Second Level and Below are \$25 per ride, Third-Fourth-FEI-Freestyles are \$35 per ride. Saturday Quadrille riders are \$10 per rider. Pas de Deux rides are \$25 per rider. Qualifying rides are available on SATURDAY only - add \$10 to your entry fee and note on entry form. Each Team also pays \$30 for Team Sponsorship (stables, businesses, etc. Teams are encouraged to use sponsor's name). Sponsor money goes into a "pay back pot"; winning team will get 60%, second place 25%, third place 15%. Sunday Championship entry fee is \$45 per ride for all levels; Sunday Quadrille rides are \$20 per rider.

- State name of team and its members on each rider's entry form.
- Horse ID Number and USDF Non-member number, if applicable, are required on each entry.
- \$20 Office Fee (includes \$1 admission). Perfect Entry Program: \$10 refund if entry is complete as submitted
- Late entry or change (after closing) of horse and/or rider \$20
- Post entries will be accepted if scheduling allows with a \$5 post-entry fee per class.
- Horses not entered in the competition or exhibition rides may not be brought onto the show grounds.
- Negative Coggins test from previous 9 months is required for all horses. Include copy w/entry.



Draw checks to CSDEA and mail to Show Secretary.

**REFUNDS:** Full refund prior to Closing Date. After closing, 50% refund only with original Veterinary certificate received by September 15, less \$20 office charge. **No refunds after September 15.**

**TIMES:** Will be posted Sept. 15 at [www.csdea.org](http://www.csdea.org). Check show program at the grounds for official times.

**STABLING:** Stabling is Mandatory (no jump-outs). Permanent stalls with doors. Original bedding (1 bag) provided; additional may be ordered on entry form for \$8/bag, available on the show grounds while supplies last. Stalls are \$70 for weekend, \$40 per day or overnight (6pm-6pm). Indicate stallions on entry form. Tack stalls \$45. Please plan your arrival — Stabling will be available **AFTER 3PM** the day before the show.

**AWARDS:** Saturday: *Windridge Inc.* will award a trophy to each member of the winning team. Sunday: *Great American Insurance Co.* will provide an award for each Championship and Freestyle Class.
