



## Silverwood Dressage

**Refunds:** Requested in writing (**email, fax or mail**) **ON or BEFORE** closing date will be honored less the office fee. **No refunds including stall fees for any reason after closing date. No changing of show dates after closing.**

**Times:** Will be posted on the web site ([www.silverwoodfarm.net](http://www.silverwoodfarm.net)) approximately one week prior to competition or entry must include SASE. Adequate time intervals cannot be guaranteed when rider enters multiple horses or if a horse has more than 1 rider. Riders will be notified via email when times are ready.

**Awards:** A prize will be awarded in all classes with 4 or more riders. Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place for all classes.

**For Saturday ONLY**-A championship Ribbon and prize will be given to the horse and rider combination with the highest % (60% minimum) one test in the following divisions: USDF Intro, Jr/Yg Rider, Adult, Open (Training-First), All divisions combined (2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup>), and FEI. Kurs are NOT Eligible. High points will be awarded on Sunday. Riders must pick all prizes and tests at the show.

**Stabling:** 10x10 permanent with doors in the stabling complex, 12x12 with doors in the main barn. When main barn is filled or not available, request will be reassigned to stabling complex. Temporary stall will be used ONLY if necessary. Shavings are \$6 per bag (bedding **NOT** included) and orders must be received with entry or by 2:00pm each day. Competitors responsible for stall damage

**Entry fees:** Intro: \$25, Training - Second: \$30, Third - Fourth: \$35, FEI & Freestyle: \$40, Jackpot class fee: \$10 (in addition to normal class fee).

**Qualifying Classes:** Qualifying classes with an **Q** in the class number will not require a separate ride. An exhibitor riding in the Open, Adult Amateur, or Junior/Young rider classes will pay an additional \$10 USDF fee to have this score entered in the Great American/USDF qualifying class at that level. Please enter the class and the qualifying class.

**Post entries** will be taken as scheduling permits, with \$10 added fee per class. All other changes made after the closing date will incur a charge of \$10 per change. During the show, the Show Secretary's office must be notified by 3:00 PM the day prior to the requested ride change if available.

**Refunds:** All fees of canceled entries in writing refunded less office fee prior to closing date. No other payments will be refunded after closing date. All entries are accepted with this understanding.

**Times:** Show management will mail ride times to all riders. Check web site for times and information at *DressageShowInfo.com*. Entries taken on a *first come, first served* basis. Remaining entries received before closing date will be placed on a wait list.

**Awards:** Divisions (Jr/Yg, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately. Riders must clearly specify division choice. When no designation is made, riders will automatically be entered as open. Riders may enter only one division per class. Trophy and six ribbons for each class. No awards for qualifying class. Special high point awards (See show program). Championship ribbons awarded to horse/rider combo with the highest and second highest average percent. Training thru second levels must ride test 4 plus two additional tests of the level. Third and fourth level must ride test 3 and one additional test. FEI level is determined by the high average with any two FEI tests required. Champion and reserve divisions awarded to Jr/Yr, Ad Am, and Open Training thru First level. Open is the only division offered for the remaining levels. In the event of a tie, a winner will be determined by the score of the highest test. All tests at a level will be averaged excluding the Freestyle score.

**Stabling and tack:** Permanent stalls with doors available from 1 PM Friday to 7 PM Sunday. \$75.00 for the show, no bedding included. Bedding available at \$6.00 per bag. Tack stalls at \$75.00. Jump out fee \$10 per horse per show.

**Accommodations:** Super 8, 15201 S. 71 Hwy, Belton, MO 816-331-0300 - ask for special show rate. RV Hookups available at \$15 per night.

**Footing:** Main performance arena are large standard outdoor arenas with sand footing. Adjacent practice arena with sand footing.



**Directions:** From the intersection of I-435 and I-470 on the SE side of Kansas City, MO: Go east on I-470, exit on Raytown Road, go right (south) for approximately 4 1/2 miles to 4-way stop (through two stop lights). Turn left (east) on High Grove and go approximately 1/2 mile to stop sign. Turn left (north) on Old Raytown Road. Horse Park will be on right, approximately one mile. Entry is well marked. From South: Exit Hwy 71 on Main Street in Grandview, go east (turns into High Grove) to stop sign at Old South Raytown Road. Turn left (north) on Old Raytown Road. Horse Park on right approximately 1 mile.

**Coggins:** Coggins within the past 12 months required. A 30 day Health Certificate is required by the state of Missouri for all horses. Horses not entered in the show may not be brought onto the show grounds without prior arrangement.

**Volunteers** are needed: Please contact show manager to lend a hand. This will count towards year-end awards requirements.

**Other:** All dogs must be leashed. Some tests (Intro and IPEC) may be performed in a small arena - all other tests will be performed in standard arena.

**Jackpot classes** will be held on Saturday and Sunday for Intro, Training, and First Level. In order to be eligible, the following is necessary: 1) must be entered in the designated class and test. 2) necessary to enter and ride another test of that level on the day of the Jackpot ride. 3) The Jackpot payback will be 100% of the Jackpot class fee (may include additional funds if available) and payback schedule will be dependent on the number of entries and may be divided by rider status/division if entries warrant. To enter, enter the normal class + Jackpot class (and if qualifying, the qualifying class). Fees will be Class fee + Jackpot fee (+ qualifying fee if including the qualifying designation for USDF)

Jr/YR/AA Classes will be split JuniorYR (21 & under) and Adult Amateur if at least three of both categories are in the class. **Freestyle:** Specify level of ride; for USEF levels enclose copy of highest test with score 58% or better at that level. **GA/USDF Qualifying Classes:** concurrent with Open or Amateur class with an additional fee of \$10. Indicate qualifying ride with 'Q' following class number and enclose copy of horse's USEF & USDF registrations.

FEI Statutes, 21st edition, effective 21<sup>st</sup> April 2004, FEI General Regulations, 21st edition, effective 1<sup>st</sup> January 2005, FEI Veterinary Regulations, 10<sup>th</sup> edition 2006, The Rules for Dressage Events (22<sup>nd</sup> edition, effective 1<sup>st</sup> January 2006), and if applicable the Rules for the World Cup Dressage Events. **Organizers Rights:** The OC retains the right to split, cancel, or change the day of a class or to further restrict the number of horses a rider may ride in any one class, also to cancel the event under special circumstances with the permission of the US Equestrian Federation and the FEI, and return entry fees. Organizer also retains the right to secure a second FEI panel of judges if entries warrant.
