Arenas: Outdoor arenas have all-weather sand footing. Warmup rings are same footing. All tests in standard arena - in case of overfill, show may elect to run some classes in a short arena. Posted schooling schedule.

Awards for USEF/FEI Classes: Divisions (Jr/Yg, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately. Riders must clearly specify division choice. When no designation is made, riders will automatically be entered as Open. Riders may enter only one division per class. Trophy (in classes of 3 or more) and ribbons to sixth for each class. No awards for Qualifying classes. Championships and reserves awarded for the highest percentage at each USEF/FEI level in each division.

No Shows: All "No Shows" that have not contacted the show office prior to their first ride will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and time slots may be filled.

Qualifying Classes: Qualifying classes with a **Q** in the class number will not require a separate ride. An exhibitor riding in the Open, Adult Amateur, or Junior/Young rider classes will pay an additional \$10 fee to have this score entered in the Great American/USDF qualifying class at that level. Please enter the class and the qualifying class.

- Office Charge:** \$20 per horse/rider combination
- Entry Information Requirement:** Competitors are responsible to include a copy of all memberships for horse, owner, rider, and trainer listed on entry form. A current negative coggins (dated within one year of show date) must also be submitted with entry.
- Late Entries:** \$25 if postmarked and received after the closing/received by date.
- Post Entries:** Will be taken as scheduling permits - Class fee plus \$10.00. Requests must be made to the show office by 3PM the day prior to the requested ride.
- Rider/Horse Change:** \$25 for either rider or horse change after entries submitted.
- Stabling/Tack Stall Fees:** \$125 for weekend stall (Barns C/D/E), bedding not included. \$150 for weekend stall (Barns A/B), bedding not included. Weekend is 12pm Thursday - 6pm Sunday. Additional nights stabling (other than show dates) \$35 per night.

Stabling and tack: Permanent 10 x 10 stalls with gates on the showgrounds. All horses must have a stall. Hay and bedding will be sold at the show. Competitors are responsible for stall damage. SMOKING IS PROHIBITED IN STALL AREAS. Stabling requests honored when possible.

Bedding: \$7 per bag. May be ordered on the entry form or from show office *by 3PM each day* - no guarantees of same day delivery if ordered after 3PM.

Non-competing horses: \$50 for horses not competing. Must fill out entry form for number and pay office fee.

Faxed Entries: Faxed entries accepted provided that a valid credit card is included to hold entry until check and original entry arrives.

Entry Cancellation/Refunds: Cancellations only in writing either by mail, e-mail or fax prior to or on closing date. **No Refunds for any reason after closing date.** All fees collected on behalf of USEF to be submitted to the Federation. **Prior to or on closing date - entire entry minus office fee.**

Other: All dogs must be leashed and attached to a person or immovable object.

Jackpot Classes: This is a class that is open to any rider (Open, AA, Jr/YG) riding in that class, namely the highest test of that level that the Jackpot is offered. There is no additional ride or ribbons but the top three riders, based on scores, share in a jackpot of total payback of nomination fees for that level. The rider nominates for a fee of \$25 (in addition to the class fee) prior to their ride and the payback is 1st - 50%, 2nd - 30%, and 3rd - 20% of the total nomination fees for that level.

Warning: Under the Equine Activity Liability Act, each participant who participates in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks of engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss, or damage to person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities.

Hazardous Weather/Acts of God/Accident Policy: Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, acts of God, or accidents. YOUNG RIDER CLASSES: Candidates for FEI Championships (NAYRC) are responsible for knowing and complying with the 2006 North American Young Riders' Championship Qualifying Criteria and Selection Procedures and all FEI and USEF rules regarding participation in qualifying competitions for this championship. Class will be run under FEI Dress and Saddlery Rules (Articles 427 and 428 of the FEI rules for Dressage). Tests must be ridden from memory and riders will not be allowed to carry a whip. No person other than the competing rider may ride the horse at any qualifying competition except for a groom who may walk the horse on a loose rein.

Entries: Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis and processed in the order received. Entries must include all signatures (original) and a copy of all association membership cards for owner/ rider/trainer/horse and must be legible. Entries must be postmarked by May 15. Faxed entries accepted with credit card payment or checks received within 5 days. Entries postmarked after the closing date will be assessed late fees with no exceptions. No refunds after closing date. Refunds, less office fee and stall fee, will be granted before closing date. Post entries will be allowed if time is available at a charge of \$10.00 plus normal fee per class. Times: Times will be mailed by the show secretary and will be available at www.tempelfarms.com as well as the show office on Thursday after 12:00 pm.

The USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal Program 2006 - Class Number S22A

The USDF, in partnership with Dover Saddlery, is sponsoring a medal program designed for adult amateurs riding at the Second Level. The USDF/Dover Medal Program will be held at participating horse shows across the country in the 2006 competition year. The USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal will be awarded to the adult amateur, who is a USDF member, riding at the Second Level with the highest score of at least 58% or better in the designated USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal Class. This is not an additional class; rather it is a designated class from the existing horse show offerings. There will be only one USDF/Dover Medal class per horse show. To be eligible, a rider must be a USDF adult amateur member in good standing. No additional memberships are required. Each USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal winner will receive a custom USDF/Dover pewter medal and neck ribbon and will have a press release announcing their win at the horse show disseminated to their local media sources and will be listed in *USDF Connection*. All USDF sanctioned horse shows are invited to offer the USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal Program.



Awards: Trophy and 6 ribbons to be given at the completion of each class. Other high percentage trophies will be given.

Stabling: Please notify management if you are arriving early or staying late. Stalls are canvas with doors. One bag of shavings will be provided for the show. **Indoor stabling is guaranteed for the first 40 stabling/tack requests on entries to sign up for it.** Additional bedding will be available for purchase. Bedding can be pre-purchased on the entry form. Please notify organizers if bringing a stallion and bring suitable equipment to close off stall to your liking. Please do not: 1) Take someone else's stall assignment! 2) Take someone else's bedding. 3) DO NOT SMOKE IN THE STABLING AREA. No refunds on stalls.

6-MONTH COGGINS is REQUIRED for all entries with NO EXCEPTIONS. Health certificates are required for out-of-state horses. Tempel Farms maintains a large breeding herd and requires this for health reasons as well as to protect the health of the competitor's horses.

Accommodations: Marriott Courtyard at 847-689-8000 or the Marroitt Residence Inn at 847-689-9240 for hotel reservations. Camping accommodations can be made at Illinois Beach State Park 847/662-4811.

Directions: From the North-Take I-94 South to Route 41 to the second stop light, Wadsworth Rd. Turn right and proceed West for approx. 1 ½ miles to the Tempel Lipizzans sign on the right side of the road. From the South-Take I-294 to the Tri-State Toll way (becomes I-94) North to Route 173 (Rosecrans Rd.). This is the next exit AFTER Route 132/Grand Ave. At the top of the ramp turn left onto Route 173 to the flashing red light, which is Hunt Club Road. Turn left and proceed to Wadsworth Rd. (approx. 2 miles). Turn left at Wadsworth Rd. and proceed to the 3rd driveway on the left by the Tempel Lipizzans sign.

Arenas/Footing: Four 20m x 60m sand competition arenas. Other designated sand arenas and large grass areas available for warm-up.

Food/Vendors: Food will be available on the show grounds. Vendor space will be available to interested parties. Please contact Show Management for information.

Farrier/Veterinarian/Emergency: Bristol Vet Service on call 262/859-2560. Farrier on grounds during scheduled hours and on call. An EMT will be on-site during show hours.

Dogs: Please do not bring them. If you must, keep them on a short leash attached to a responsible adult.

Weather/Accident and Emergencies Policy: Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, accidents, or emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any championship or qualifying class being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, accidents, or emergencies.

(GR 1401) Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Neither the Organizing Committee, show volunteers and staff, the facility or its owners will be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses, or property of exhibitors or spectators. All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

Show management reserves the right to vary or add officials and refuse any entry for a cause; to disqualify any exhibitor and/or his or her horse for cause; to cause an exhibitor to forfeit his or her ribbons or winning for cause; to return any entry and/or stall fee before or during the show for cause; all

Class Fees: Intro: \$23.00; Training: \$28.00; First/Second: \$33.00
Third/Fourth/Freestyles: \$38.00
Qualifying Classes: Must be entered in the appropriate Jr/YR, AA, or Open class. Add \$10.00 for each qualifying test.
Camper or RV: \$25 per night for camper hook-ups. \$15 per night for tent camping.
Office Charge: \$25 per horse/rider combination.
Payment: Entries accepted by mail; check must accompany entry. No credit cards accepted; no entries accepted by fax or email.
Late Entries: \$20 flat fee on all late entries (received after closing date) plus an additional \$5 per class; post entries, changes in the rider or horse also subject to \$5 per class fee.
Concessions: Concession stand on grounds during show hours.
Stabling/Tack Fees: \$80 for stall from Thur-Sun or \$70 for stall from Fri - Sun for a horse. All horses must be stabled. \$40 for weekend for tack stall. \$40 per "day" for either a horse or tack stall. Stall "days" are 24 hour periods defined as: 3 PM Friday – 3 PM Saturday and 3 PM Saturday – 3 PM Sunday
Bedding: One bag provided. Extra bedding at \$7 per bag may be ordered on the entry form or from show office while supplies last.
Non-competing horse: \$50 for horses not competing; Must fill out entry form for number and pay office and stabling fees.

Refunds: Entries canceled on or before closing date will receive a 100% refund of all fees. No refund of entries if canceled after the closing date.

Times: Unofficial times will be mailed to all riders one week before the show. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule.

Awards: Ribbons to sixth place in all classes except qualifying classes. Champion high point will also be awarded at each division and level. Divisions (Jr/YR, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately; riders may only enter one division per class. Champions and Reserve awarded for highest average percentage (must enter at least 2 classes per level to qualify.)

Stabling and tack: Permanent stalls with doors available on the fairgrounds. Some stalls may be 8' x 8'. Please contact secretary if a larger stall is necessary.

Arenas: All classes in large sand arenas. Warm-up areas are on sand or sand and grass footing.

Other: All dogs must be leashed. All horses must have a current (within current calendar year) Coggins test. Submit copy with entry. Horses not entered in the show may not be brought onto the show grounds without prior consent from the management. No smoking in stall areas or show office.
